

## **Program/After-School Program Policy**

### **Attendee Behavior**

The library has a zero-tolerance policy for bullying in any library space, gathering, or program. We are dedicated to maintaining a safe environment for all patrons. Every individual, regardless of age, is expected to comply with the following rules:

1. Running inside the library is strictly prohibited.
2. Screaming is unacceptable; all patrons must use indoor voices at all times, except when expressly instructed to shout during a program.
3. Hitting, kicking, or disrespectful behavior toward others will not be tolerated.

If these rules are violated, the following disciplinary actions will be enforced:

- First violation: Your child will receive an immediate warning.
- Second violation: Your child will be required to skip the next program or after-school activity.
- Third violation: Your child will be barred from attending the next two programs or after-school activities.
- Fourth violation: Your child will be prohibited from returning until accompanied by an adult for the entirety of the program. Guardians will be promptly notified after each incident to ensure transparency and communication.

### **Age Considerations**

All library programs are age-restricted. Adults, teens, and children must not register for or attend programs intended for a specific age group unless they have first discussed this matter with library staff.

### **Photography**

Participants should be aware that photographs and videos will be taken during library events. These images may be used on the library's social media platforms, website, and in library-produced publications. Third-party presenters and program leaders are required to adhere to the library's photography policy.
