

Graettinger Public Library Rules of Conduct

Recognizing the need to maintain an environment suitable for studying, reading, browsing and general use of the library resources, the Library Board establishes the following rules of conduct to assure the safety of library users, personnel, and materials. We thank you for your cooperation.

- Please be considerate of others using the library.
- Please attend young children at all times.
- Please wear shoes at all times.
- Please do not litter.
- No smoking in the library.
- No sleeping, loitering, or soliciting permitted on library premises.
- No disorderly or disruptive behavior permitted on library premises.
- No harassment of library patrons or personnel is permitted.
- Please do not damage library material or property.

Entering the library implies agreement to abide by these rules while in the library. Violation of any of these rules may subject the individual(s) involved to exclusion from the library for a period of time.

Meeting Room: All non-profit organizations may use the meeting room. Other organizations may use it at the discretion of the librarian. The meeting room may not be used by anyone under 18 years of age without an adult present. The meeting room must be left in the condition that it was found.
